If you're arriving from the East, take a Left at the end of the exit onto WV Rt. 857 (Cheat Road), drive across the bridge over I-68 through the light and take the next Left. Mid-Atlantic Sports Cars is on the left.

If you're interested in staying the night, lodging is available at the Glenmark Center, located less than 1/2 mile away.
